ORDINANCE NO.: 2022-119

Amending the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 9, Fire Prevention and Protection, Article IV, Fire Prevention Code, Sec. 9-61, Adoption

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 17th day of January, 2023, that the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 9, Fire Prevention and Protection, Article IV, Fire Prevention Code, Sec. 9-61, Adoption, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 9-61. Adoption.


(a) There is hereby adopted by the city council, for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire or explosion, that certain code known as the 2021 Edition of the International Fire Code as adopted and modified by amendment of the South Carolina Building Code Council and published by the International Code Council, Inc., Section 103 and its subsections (enumerated as Sections 103.1, 103.2 and 103.3) and 104.7 are expressly excluded from the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia.

(b) In the event of any conflict between the provisions of the code adopted by this section and state law or city ordinances, rules or regulations, then the code adopted by this section shall prevail and be controlling, unless the code is specifically amended by state law which shall prevail and be controlling.

This ordinance is effective as of final reading.
