

RESOLUTION NO.: R-2022-005

Approving and Ratifying Mutual Aid Agreements between the City of Columbia and the City of Columbia Police Department and Various Law Enforcement Agencies and Authorizing the City Manager of the City of Columbia and the Chief of Police of the City of Columbia to execute all such Agreements

WHEREAS, the South Carolina Law Enforcement Assistance and Support Act, codified in Section 23-20-10 through 23-20-60 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina (2016) authorizes law enforcement agencies of the State of South Carolina (the "State") to enter into contractual agreements with other law enforcement providers as may be necessary for the proper and prudent exercise of public safety functions; and,

WHEREAS, the Columbia Police Department ("CPD") is desirous of entering into agreements with various law enforcement agencies in the State, in order to properly and prudently exercise public safety functions in a manner which benefits the citizens the City and the State; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia, as the governing body of the City ("City Council") believes the adoption, execution and use of multi-jurisdictional agreements to be reasonable, prudent and desirable, and that such agreements serve the best interest of the citizens of the City; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-20-40(B) of the *Code of Laws of South Carolina* (2016) all multi-jurisdictional agreements be approved by the respective governing bodies for each agency; and,

WHEREAS, there are certain jurisdictions and law enforcement agencies with whom the Columbia Police Department has had long standing cooperative relationships and entering into agreements with those jurisdictions and agencies should be facilitated; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the Police Chief of the City (the "Chief"), as the lead law enforcement officer for the City and the City Manager of the City (the "City Manager"), as the chief executive officer of the City, are qualified and shall be authorized by City Council to enter into multi-jurisdictional agreements with the select jurisdictions and agencies with which the City of Columbia has enjoyed a strong relationship; and,

WHEREAS, none of the Mutual Aid Agreements provide for any expenditure of funds from the City of Columbia above Fifty Thousand and No/100 (\$50,000.00) Dollars, so the City Manager is authorized to sign said documents; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, this 18th day of January, 2022, as follows:

- 1. The Chief and the City Manager, acting together, are authorized to execute and enter into mutual aid agreements with various law enforcement agencies with which the City of Columbia has enjoyed long standing cooperative relationships. A list of all governmental agencies to which the Chief and City Manager are authorized to so act and agree is attached hereto as Exhibit "A". The Chief and the City Manager are specifically authorized and vested with the power to execute and negotiate any and all mutual aid agreements with such entities (the "Agreements").
- 2. To the extent any such Agreement is executed by the Chief and the City Manager, it shall be valid and binding against the City (and CPD) and upon their joint execution thereof, such Agreement shall be deemed ratified, confirmed and approved by City Council.

- 3. The approval and ratification powers granted herein applies to and validates all actions previously taken or to be taken by the Chief and/or the City Manager, any action taken or to be taken by the City or CPD under such agreements (as executed by the Chief and the City Manager), including, but not limited to, joint operations, extra-jurisdictional arrests, multi-jurisdictional investigations, sharing of personal and/or equipment, and all other activities authorized by applicable law and by the terms of the respective agreements.
- 4. Any amendment or necessary change to the list of entities in the attached Exhibit "A" shall be approved by City Council by and through an express written amendment hereto.
- 5. The authorization for the Chief and the City Manager to act under the provisions hereof, including the term of any Agreements authorized under the provisions of this Resolution, shall be binding until December 31, 2023, unless the authorization for the Chief and/or the City Manager to so act is revoked by the City Council, or otherwise amended.
