Approving the Planting of a Tree and Placement of a Plaque at the Southwest Corner of the South Carolina Crime Victims' Memorial Garden and Path of Remembrance in the Riverfront Park South Parking Lot in Remembrance of Officer Roy Andrew "Drew" Barr, Jr.

WHEREAS, Officer Roy Andrew "Drew" Barr, Jr. was employed with the Cayce Police Department and killed in the line of duty while responding to a domestic violence call; and

WHEREAS, Laura Hudson, victims' advocate, founded the South Carolina Crime Victims' Memorial Garden and Path of Remembrance located at the south parking lot of Riverfront Park and dedicated it to victims of crime throughout the state of South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Hush No More and the Cayce Police Department are hosting the 4th Annual Domestic Violence Walk and Community Outreach, paying tribute to Officer Roy Andrew "Drew" Barr, Jr. on October 15, 2022 from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at Riverfront Park; and

WHEREAS, in honor of Officer Roy Andrew "Drew" Barr, Jr., the site will be marked with a symbolic tree during Hush No More's October 15 Domestic Violence Awareness Walk at the park. Sometime in December, around Arbor Day, the park staff plans to plant a majestic 4-inch caliper cherrybark oak tree donated by Gray Howard of Long Branch Farm and host an event to encourage others to plant and nurture trees; NOW THEREFORE;

BE IT RESOLVED this 4th day of October, 2022, that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia hereby approve the planting of a tree and placement of a plaque at the southwest corner of the South Carolina Crime Victims' Memorial Garden and Path of Remembrance in the Riverfront Park south parking lot in remembrance of Officer Roy Andrew "Drew" Barr, Jr.

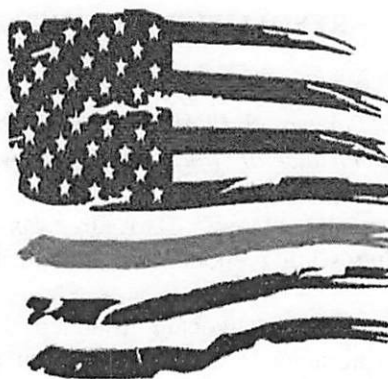

The site will initially be marked with a symbolic tree during Hush No More's October 15 Domestic Violence Awareness Walk at the park. In December, around Arbor Day, park staff will plant a majestic 4-inch caliper Cherrybark Oak donated by Gray Howard of Long Branch Farm and host an event encouraging others to plant and nurture trees.

This tree will enhance our park's entry and to provide welcome shade to those who stop to reflect in the garden.
