RESOLUTION NO.: R-2026-003

Permitting the City of Columbia Fire Department to collect money for the Muscular Dystrophy Association

WHEREAS, the Columbia Fire Department requests permission pursuant to South Carolina Code Ann. §5-27-910 for their personnel to collect money to benefit the Muscular Dystrophy Association at the intersections of Huger Street and Blossom Street; Gervais Street and Millwood Avenue; Bull Street and Elmwood Avenue; Harbison Boulevard and Columbiana Drive; Fairfield Road and N. Main Street; Leesburg Road and Garners Ferry Road, on Wednesday, February 11, 2026, Thursday, February 12, 2026 and Friday, February 13, 2026; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, South Carolina this 6th day of January, 2026, that the Columbia Fire Department personnel are permitted to collect money for the Muscular Dystrophy Association on Wednesday, February 11, 2026, Thursday, February 12, 2026 and Friday, February 13, 2026, at the intersections of Huger Street and Blossom Street; Gervais Street and Millwood Avenue; Bull Street and Elmwood Avenue; Harbison Boulevard and Columbiana Drive; Fairfield Road and N. Main Street; Leesburg Road and Garners Ferry Road, provided, however, that: (1) there is no interference with either vehicular or pedestrian traffic; (2) no personnel shall leave the curb or raised median while soliciting for or collecting funds; and (3) personnel shall remove all trash from the sidewalk and median.


