

**ORDINANCE NO.: 2005-012**

*Amending the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina,  
Chapter 22, Streets, Sidewalks and Other Public Places, Article V,  
Utility Installations in Streets to add Sec. 22-137, Underground utilities*

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 16th day of February, 2005, that the 1998 Code of Ordinances of The City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 22, Streets, Sidewalks and Other Public Places, Article V, Utility Installations in Streets, is amended to add Sec. 22-137, Underground utilities to read as follows:

**Sec. 22-137. Underground utilities**

It shall be unlawful to erect, construct, maintain or use any pole, overhead wires or associated structure for new service or in replacement of existing service, excepting such poles as are necessary to support street lighting, traffic signals, and transmission lines above forty-three thousand (43,000) volts.

This ordinance is effective as of final reading.


