Vacating and closing an unopened portion of Roberts Street and a Forty (40') portion of Calhoun Street for the Winter Shelter

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia is constructing a winter shelter within the unopened portion of Roberts Street and a portion of Calhoun Street as shown on the attached drawing; and,

WHEREAS, these streets are owned by the City of Columbia; and,

WHEREAS, closing and vacating the unopened portion of Roberts Street and a forty (40') foot portion of Calhoun Street are required for the construction of the winter shelter buildings; and,

WHEREAS, the unopened portion of Roberts Street and the forty (40') foot portion of Calhoun Street are not required for public use or convenience; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council this 28th day of November, 2007 that the unopened portion of Roberts Street and a forty (40') foot portion of Calhoun Street as shown on the attached drawing be closed for public use as a street and vacated in order to allow for the construction of the winter shelter buildings.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that title to said streets shall remain vested in the City of Columbia.
