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#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2009-060**

Granting encroachment to the University of South Carolina Development Foundation for installation and maintenance of an irrigation system, seventeen trees and fifty-one concrete car stops within the right of way areas of the 700 blocks of Greene Street, Gadsden Street and Devine Street adjacent to Richland County TMS No. 08915-12-01

WHEREAS, the University of South Carolina Development Foundation (hereinafter "Grantee") desires to install and maintain an irrigation system, seventeen (17) trees and fifty-one (51) concrete car stops within the right way areas of the 700 blocks of Greene Street, Gadsden Street and Devine Street adjacent to Richland County MS No. 08915-12-01, as shown on the attached drawing; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that the encroachment will not interfere with the use of the medians or street for raffic, utility locations or other uses within the foreseeable future; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, this 15th day of July, 2009 that Grantee is hereby granted the right to install and maintain an irrigation system, seventeen (17) trees and fifty-one (51) concrete car stops within the right of way areas of the 700 blocks of Greene Street, Gadsden Street and Devine Street adjacent to Richland County TMS No. 08915-12-01, as shown on the attached drawing.

ALL WORK SHALL COMPLY with the requirements of The City of Columbia and South Carolina Department of Transportation now in existence or hereafter enacted. The materials and type of finish to be used are to be approved by the City Engineer prior to installation. Any damage to the street or sidewalk caused by construction shall be repaired to the satisfaction of the City Manager. Improvements within the encroachment shall be maintained by the grantee at no cost to the City in a manner approved by the City Manager.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that in exercising the privileges granted under this ordinance, Grantee, its successors and assigns, will indemnify and save harmless the City from any and all claims or causes of action which may arise by reason of the construction or maintenance of the aforesaid encroachment.

PROVIDED FURTHER that the privilege granted hereby is subject to the Grantee complying with the following conditions, restrictions or limitations:

- 1. There shall not be a reduction in the current width of the roadway;
- 2. Irrigation must be designed to avoid spraying walkways, sidewalks and streets and/or creating hazardous conditions upon the walkways, sidewalks and streets;

PROVIDED FURTHER that the privilege granted hereby may be modified or terminated by Columbia City Council at any time without notice to the Grantee, its successors and assigns.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Grantee, in consideration of the above privilege, shall at its expense provide for protection and relocation of all utilities that might be within this area to the satisfaction of the City Manager.

#### REQUEST FOR AN ENCROACHMENT ORDINANCE

For a continuing encroachment on any type of property in which the City has an interest (i.e., rights of way, tree zone, sidewalk, streets), the person or entity is required to have an encroachment ordinance enacted by City Council permitting the encroachment. Encroachment ordinances are required for but not limited to: irrigation systems; landscaping; fencing; walls; pavers; walkways; outdoor dining items (chairs, tables, umbrellas, etc.); awnings; urds and directional signs (i.e., churches) Business signs are NOT permitted via an encroachment. An encroachment must comply with all existing codes, rules and regulations, the Americans With Disabilities Act, if applicable, and is subject to review and approval by City staff. Enactment of the encroachment ordinance by a majority vote of City Council, which is a discretionary legislative act, is also required.


The Greene Street Intramural Fields project proposes to re-develop an existing gravel parking lot to provide recreational field space for University students. The parcel consists of 3.7 acres, bounded by Greene, Gadsden, and Devine Streets as well as a Norfolk Southern rail line.


To comply with the City of Columbia's landscape ordinance, tree planting is required, but is not compatible with the proposed use of the site. After meeting with City staff, the tree planting requirement was modified to allow this obligation to be met on the right-of-way.

The encroachment permit is requested to allow planting of (17) 4" caliper Overcup Oaks, sited in the openings between existing trees. The new trees would be protected with three (3) concrete car stops at each tree; these would be anchored with two rebar pins each. Drip irrigation would be extended to each tree from a trunk line inside the property boundary and fence. In addition, the ground surface along Green Street and Gadsden Street would be weeded, scarified, and overseeded with grass seed. The Devine Street right-of-way, which has a more pronounced slope, would remain as-is to avoid erosion problems. Any areas of the Devine Street frontage disturbed during construction would be repaired and seeded.

As the roads in question did have a state number designation on the property survey, it was initially thought that the streets were maintained by SC DOT. An encroachment permit application was submitted to the Richland County Maintenance office. According to the Resident Maintenance Engineer, DOT does not maintain the street sections in question (see attached letter).

Regarding the insurance requirement, state law prohibits USC from naming any parties as additional insured. According to Brian Hann at USC's Office of Risk Management, the City's Legal Department has agreed in the past to waive the insurance requirement for USC projects. A previous project on Greene Street was granted an encroachment permit (#2006-034) without the insurance certificate.






