Granting an encroachment to the Laurens Street Homeowners Association for installation and maintenance of a brick wall and columns with iron fencing within the right of way area adjacent to 1020 Laurens Street, 1022 Laurens Street, 1024 Laurens Street, 1026 Laurens Street, 1028 Laurens Street and 1030 Laurens Street, known as Richland County TMS #11405-11-30, 11405-11-31, 11405-11-32, 11405-11-33, 11405-11-34 and 11405-11-35

WHEREAS, the Laurens Street Homeowners Association, (hereinafter "Grantee") desires to utilize a portion of the right of way area adjacent to the property at 1020 Laurens Street, 1022 Laurens Street, 1024 Laurens Street, 1026 Laurens Street, 1028 Laurens Street and 1030 Laurens Street known as Richland County TMS #11405-11-30, 11405-11-31, 11405-11-32, 11405-11-33,11405-11-34 and 11405-11-35, for installation and maintenance of a brick wall and columns with iron fencing approximately five (5') feet in height and one hundred twenty-six (126') feet in length within the right of way area, as shown on the attached drawing; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that the encroachment will not interfere with the use of the sidewalk or street for traffic, utility locations or other uses within the foreseeable future; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, this 2nd day of September, 2009, that Grantee, its successors and assigns, is hereby granted the right to utilize a portion of the right of way area adjacent to 1020 Laurens Street, 1022 Laurens Street, 1024 Laurens Street, 1026 Laurens Street, 1028 Laurens Street and 1030 Laurens Street known as Richland County TMS #11405-11-30, 11405-11-31, 11405-11-32, 11405-11-33,11405-11-34 and 11405-11-35, for installation and maintenance of a brick wall and columns with iron fencing approximately five (5') feet in height and one hundred twenty-six (126') feet in length within the right of way area, as shown on the attached drawing.

ALL WORK SHALL COMPLY with the requirements of The City of Columbia and South Carolina Department of Transportation now in existence or hereafter enacted. The materials and type of finish to be used are to be approved by the City Engineer prior to installation. Any damage to the street or sidewalk caused by construction or maintenance shall be repaired to the satisfaction of the City Manager. Improvements constructed within the encroachment by or on behalf of Grantee shall be maintained by the Grantee at no cost to the City in a manner approved by the City Manager.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that in exercising the privileges granted under this ordinance, Grantee, its successors and assigns, will indemnify and save harmless the City

from any and all claims or causes of action which may arise by reason of the construction or maintenance of the aforesaid encroachment.

PROVIDED FURTHER that the privilege granted hereby is subject to the Grantee complying with the following conditions, restrictions or limitations:

- 1. Fence cannot impede fire department access;
- 2. Column height and width cannot impede sight distance.

PROVIDED FURTHER that the privilege granted hereby may be modified or terminated by Columbia City Council at any time without notice to the Grantee, its successors and assigns.

PROVIDED FURTHER that a certificate of insurance be issued as evidence of general liability insurance with at least the minimum amount of \$600,000.00 for personal injury and property damage and naming the City as an insured, be provided to and filed annually with the City Clerk by Grantee, its successors and assigns, as required by Chapter 11, Licenses, Permits, Business Regulations, Article III, Contractors, Sec. 11-71, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Grantee, in consideration of the above privilege, shall at its expense provide for protection and, if necessary, relocation of all utilities that might be within this area to the satisfaction of the City Manager.

REQUEST FOR AN ENCROACHMENT ORDINANCE

For a continuing encroachment on any type of property in which the City has an interest (i.e., rights of way, tree zone, sidewalk, streets), the person or entity is required to have an encroachment ordinance enacted by City Council permitting the encroachment. Encroachment ordinances are required for but not limited to: irrigation systems; landscaping; fencing; walls; pavers; walkways; outdoor dining items (chairs, tables, umbrellas, etc.); awnings; bollards and directional signs (i.e., churches) Business signs are NOT permitted via an encroachment. An encroachment must comply with all existing City codes, rules and regulations, the Americans With Disabilities Act, if applicable, and is subject to review and approval by City staff. Enactment of the encroachment ordinance by a majority vote of City Council, which is a discretionary legislative act, is also required.

South end of proposed decorative and protective all/fence there are cubs at the main entrance to the property.

There are no city streets or any other type of trees or scrubs involved

We request a decorative and protective iron fence with brick columns in keeping with many others in this University neighborhood area to offer security to residents from increased foot traffic and panhandlers. We have suffered many and increasing incidents of theft; break-ins (2), curious motor traffic to the rear of our units and trespassing pets. There are small children playing in this grassed area bordered by speeding university students on Laurens St. This decorative barrier provides obvious safety. The two columns at the entrance will clarify that this is private property and assist with the emergency address identification of these residences. At present there are over 15 homes with similar wall/fences within 3 blocks in this University neighborhood. This enhances the efforts by the neighborhood and city to identify this distinct neighborhood begun by the installation of period lighting 4 years ago.

We are in essence completing a wall initially stared and paid for by the city in front of half of our development for vehicle safety. It has inadvertently resulted in an unsettling and unfinished appearance.

We plan to pay for this improvement and maintain it ourselves. The city built wall has saved at least 3 individuals from crashing down a ravine causing damage to this wall. The city has repaired this wall twice. We would like to extend this excellent "crash barrier" to the end of our property.

W will have the structure included in our property insurance and hold the city of Columbia harmless.


