

RESOLUTION NO.: R-2005-060

Authorizing Sidewalk Sale for Five Points Merchants

WHEREAS, the Five Points retail merchants (the Merchants) are sponsoring a sidewalk sale for merchants located within Five Points in conjunction with the Blues Fest and Chili Cook-Off on Saturday, October 15, 2005; and,

WHEREAS, the Merchants have requested permission to conduct sidewalk sales as part of the celebration; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 5th day of October, 2005 that between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 15, 2005, Merchants are authorized to sell items normally sold in their course of business, except alcoholic beverages, beer and wine, on the sidewalks immediately in front of their places of business; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that only pedestrian traffic will be allowed within the area. All other traffic, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles, skate boards, and horses, except police horses, is prohibited. All pets shall be prohibited. Coolers, glass bottles and breakable glasses and/or cups shall be prohibited; and,

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that sidewalks shall not be obstructed for pedestrian traffic in violation of Sec. 14-32, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, and that no vendor locations be allowed on any street during the period of the celebration.





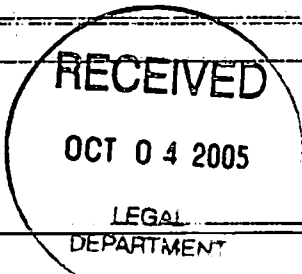
