

**RESOLUTION NO.: R-2008-012**

*Authorizing consumption of beer and wine at the  
South Carolina Oyster Festival in Capital City Stadium*

WHEREAS, Liquid Assets ("Sponsor") is sponsoring the South Carolina Oyster Festival in Capital City Stadium from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 12, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, the Sponsor has requested permission to allow the consumption of beer and wine beverages by its patrons at the event; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 2nd day of April, 2008 that the sale of beer and wine is authorized between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 12, 2008 in Capital City Stadium.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all pets shall be prohibited. Patrons are prohibited from bringing alcoholic beverages, glass bottles and breakable glasses and/or cups, grills and radios, boom boxes and other musical devices, backpacks and large bags; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that coolers of food and non-alcoholic beverages shall be allowed; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the designated time the amphitheater area of Capital City Stadium shall be declared to be a Public Park and provisions of Chapter 15, Parks and Recreation, Sec. 15-1, 15-2 and 15-3, Code of Ordinances of the City of



Pursuant to Chapter 14, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, Article IV, Offenses Against the Public Peace and Order, Sec. 14-99, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, Capital City Stadium is deemed to be the site of a public festival at which beer and wine may be consumed and the prohibition against possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages as set forth in Sec. 14-99 shall not apply.


