People desiring to vote in the upcoming election must be registered in person by Saturday, October 5, 2019; online by Sunday, October 6, 2019 or by mail postmarked by Monday, October 7, 2019. To register, one must contact the County Board of Voter Registration.

Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the above listed offices must pay the required fee and file a Statement of Intention of Candidacy with the City Clerk, 3rd floor, City Hall, 1737 Main Street, Columbia, South Carolina. Books will be open for filing on Monday, August 19, 2019 at noon, and remain open during regular business hours (8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.) until Friday, September 6, 2019 at noon. No Statement of Intention of Candidacy will be accepted after noon on Friday, September 6, 2019.

The filing fee for the office of Council is \$530.00.

This is a nonpartisan election and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot.

The polls shall open at 7:00 a.m. on Election Day and close at 7:00 p.m. Within forty-eight hours after the closing of the polls, any candidate may contest the result of the election as reported by the managers by filing a written notice of such contest together with a concise statement of the grounds therefor with the Municipal Election Commission. Within forty eight hours after the filing of such notice, the Municipal Election Commission shall, after due notice to the parties concerned, conduct a hearing on the contest, decide the issues raised, file its report together with all recorded testimony and exhibits with the clerk of court of the county in which the municipality is situated, notify the parties concerned of the decisions made, and when the decision invalidates the election the council shall order a new election as to the parties concerned.

Neither the mayor nor any member of council shall be eligible to pass on the issues arising in any contest in which he is a party. (S.C. Code Sec. 5-15-130, et seq.)

At 9:00 a.m. on said Election Day the commissioners will begin examination of the absentee ballot return envelopes. This examination will be held in the 4th Floor Conference Room, Richland County Administration Building, 2020 Hampton Street, Columbia, South Carolina.

On Thursday, November 7, 2019 at 10:00 a.m., in the 4th Floor Conference Room, Richland County Administration Building, 2020 Hampton Street, Columbia, South Carolina, the Municipal Election Commission shall hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged, if any, in this election.

Any run-off will be held two weeks after the election on Tuesday, November 19, 2019.
