

ORDINANCE NO.: 2017-059

Granting an Easement to BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T S.C. along a Portion of City Property Identified as Lexington County TMS#00700-05-033 for Traffic Circle Improvements at the Intersection of Old Lexington Highway and Murray Lindler Road; CF#250-400A

WHEREAS, BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T has made a request for an easement comprising 900 square feet on a portion of the subject City-owned property for relocation and installation of telecommunication lines and associated facilities for construction of a traffic circle and roadway improvements at the intersection of Old Lexington Highway and Murray Lindler Road; and,

WHEREAS, the plans for the proposed utility installations have been reviewed and approved by the Department of Engineering and there are no conflicts with existing or planned City utilities. This property was formerly the site of a water pump station which has been abandoned and the site is currently vacant; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, South Carolina this 1st day of August, 2017, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, each to the other paid, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an easement on behalf of the City of Columbia to **BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, LLC D/B/A AT&T S.C.** for ingress, egress, installation and maintenance of telecommunication lines and associated facilities along a portion of the subject property.

The referenced easement is shown on a drawing prepared for AT&T for the Old Lexington Hwy/Murray Lindler Rd. Traffic Circle Improvements Project, PM Tool #1800684, and being on file in the office of the Department of Engineering under file reference #250-400A. A copy of said drawing being attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A".
