WHEREAS, Deacon Felder has always been engaged with his customers getting to know them and their families; some customers stop in just for the conversation and many have become life-long customers, who now bring their children in for haircuts. Deacon Felder never turned a customer away, if they were unable to pay he would find chores or errands for them to do and would encourage them to attend church; and,

WHEREAS, Deacon Felder is actively involved in the Waverly Community; serves on the boards of the Benedict-Allen Community Development Corporation and C.A. Johnson Alumna Association; is a member of the Palmetto Barber Association, having served as its president for eight years; and,

WHEREAS, Deacon Felder was awarded the Top Community Service Award for the Waverly Community and Man of the Year by the Second Nazareth Baptist Church, and served as an original member of the Drew Wellness Center Advisory Committee; and,

WHEREAS, the community has so much respect and appreciation for Deacon Felder that they raised funds to do a surprise renovation of the barbershop while he was on vacation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED this 7th day of February, 2017, that the Mayor and Columbia City Council do hereby approve the honorary naming of the intersections of Elmwood Avenue and Barhamville Road "Deacon Moses Felder Square".
