STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA) INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT) BETWEEN RICHLAND COUNTY AND THE COUNTY OF RICHLAND) CITY OF COLUMBIA (Lake Katherine Sediment Removal)

This Agreement entered into this 24th day of April , 2017, by and between Richland County, South Carolina (the "County"), and the City of Columbia, South Carolina (the "City").

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, the City and The Home Owners Association of Lake Katherine, Inc. ("LKHOA") have executed the Project Agreement, dated June 21, 2016, for the purpose of collaborating to remove the sediment/silt in Lake Katherine (the "Project"), which is private lake located in the City of Columbia and owned by the LKHOA; and

WHEREAS, the Project is vital to the County's watershed management and will have positive environmental effects on the County's watercourses and stormwater runoff; and

WHEREAS, the importance of Lake Katherine to the management of the watershed was made more poignant by the October 2015 overtopping of Lake Katherine dam during the historic flood

WHEREAS, Lake Katherine HOA has agreed, upon request of the City, during threats of inclement weather predicting a 10-year storm level of greater, reducing the Lake level to allow for excess stormwater storage in the Lake,

WHEREAS, the County has agreed to provide a portion of funding for the Project;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and of the mutual covenants herein set forth, the parties agree as follows:

- The Project will be performed pursuant to the Project Agreement, to which the County is not a party.
- The County shall not be responsible for any portion of the Project, including any design services, right-of-way acquisition, mobilization, traffic control, clearing and grubbing, drainage and erosion control, and appropriate inspection services.
- 3. The County agrees to provide to the City, for the sole purpose of partially funding the Project and pursuant to the Project Agreement, an amount equal to \$62,400.00. The City will then provide the same funding to Lake Katherine HOA only upon request for such through an invoice reflecting a portion of the work that has been performed.
- 4. Should work on the Project fail to commence within one (1) year, or fail to be completed with two (2) years, from the from the date of execution of this Agreement, the City shall return the funds in full to the County.
- 5. Should the Project be completed for less than the Project budget, as provided in the Project Agreement, the City shall return to the County a pro-rated amount based on the cost savings and the percentage of funding provided by each of the three entities.

6. This Agreement represents the entire and integrated agreement between the County and the City.
