**ORDINANCE NO: 2021-094**

*Repealing Ordinance No.: 2021-081 that Extended Emergency Ordinance No.: 2021-078  
Related to COVID-19*

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No.: 2021-081 enacted on October 5, 2021, City Council extended Ordinance No.: 2021-078 that temporarily suspended the normal operating procedures of City Council and City Boards and Commissions meetings as well as requiring facial coverings in all public places within the City to slow the spread of the novel coronavirus disease, known as COVID-19; and,

WHEREAS, Council desires to have said Ordinance repealed; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, this 9<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2021, that the restrictions heretofore enacted by Ordinance No.: 2021-078 and extended by Ordinance No.: 2021-081 are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
